The requested return date was yesterday, February 11th. Your cooperation in helping us to meet this responsibility is appreciated. Thank you!

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We are instituting a "green" policy this year for re-registration. Nearly all of our students re-register for the following school year and we will assume that this will be the case for this year also. Our business manager will include the \$25 fee per child in your February statement unless you notify the school office to let us know that you are NOT returning.

Kindergarten students received a separate re-registration form to return to the office. Your promptness in returning this form enables us to give accurate information regarding class size, etc. to prospective parents who have requested further information.

Our hope is that these changes expedite the process for registration for the 2009-2010 school year.
